The reception, which is held annually to celebrate the recipients and thank the generous donors, was attended by over 175 people.

Every scholarship fund established at Main Street Community Foundation has a unique and personal story behind its creation, as well as a donor committed to supporting the academic and career dreams of students in Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington, and Wolcott.

This year, MSCF awarded 194 students with a total of \$360,000 in scholarships, the announcement from MSCF states.
