



## SCHOLARSHIP DIRECTORY SPRING 2017

This directory lists all scholarships available through Main Street Community Foundation in 2017. The scholarships listed alphabetically on pages 1-22 are available to graduating high school seniors, current college students and/or adult learners and utilize an online application. The scholarships listed on pages 23-24 are available to elementary and secondary school students as well as select graduating high school seniors and utilize separate applications.

The code to the left of the scholarship name depicts the town or towns that the student must be a resident of in order to be eligible to apply and are as follows:

### **Ply - Christian Arndt Scholarship Fund**

**\$370**

This award was set up through a bequest from the estate of Terryville resident Christian Arndt, who passed away in 2004.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Graduating senior from Terryville High School
- Academic achievement especially in the area of science

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation.

**Essay Requirement:** No essay required.

### **Br, Bu, Ply - E. Bartlett Barnes Award of Journalism Fund**

**up to \$4,680**

This award was established in 1980 by a group of community friends wishing to pay tribute to Bart Barnes, retired publisher of the Bristol Press, whose association with this newspaper spanned 48 years until his retirement in 1985. His lifelong love of journalism and community service is well-known in the Bristol area, and it is difficult to find a local organization in which Mr. Barnes had not been active.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Residents of Bristol, Burlington and Plymouth
- Evidence of interest in journalism, creative writing and/or related studies
- Scholastic achievement
- Financial need
- Combination of leadership and "good citizenship" skills in school and community

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation.

**Essay Requirement:** Write an essay explaining what your involvement in the field of journalism and/or creative writing has been, how you feel it has helped you and those around you and your plans to use it in the future.

**So – Because of 26 Kindness Award Scholarship****\$1,000**

This award was established in 2014 by two Southington residents, Lisa Wrubleski and Erin Furniss, who in response to the tragedy in Sandy Hook vowed to have their daughters grow up in a community inspired by the beautiful acts of kindness which have come from the horrific event.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Graduating senior from Southington High School*
- *Must demonstrate good character, citizenship and kindness to others*
- *Be accepted at and planning to attend an accredited college/university*
- *Evidence of continuous community/church service and/or community involvement*
- *Special consideration will be given to those who create an event/activity which focuses on kindness*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be able to validate your act of kindness.

**Essay Requirement:** Submit an essay on how you have impacted the community with your (continued) act(s) of kindness towards others and how you inspired others to do the same. Describe why you feel you are a representative of one who displays outward kindness to others. If you have created an event/activity which focuses on kindness, be sure to discuss that.

**Note the deadline for this application is March 13, 2017.**

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo, O - Sid Bernard Memorial Art Scholarship Fund****\$1,600**

This scholarship was established in 2009 to honor the memory of Sid Bernard, a visual arts teacher who taught art in the Bristol Public schools from 1984-2009.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Graduating senior or graduate from one of the public high schools in Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington, Wolcott or a graduating senior or graduate of Litchfield High School*
- *Pursuing either a two or four year college with a major in visual arts or art education*
- *Include any summer programs or educational opportunities that you participated in*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendations from art instructors who must comment on the student's art ability.

**Additional Required Materials:** Must submit 3 copies of your portfolio on CDROM; include 8 works of art as digital files. The method of presentation of the portfolio is extremely important; the work must be photographed in front of a neutral solid background with lighting that will best present the work. If the piece is three-dimensional include multiple views. Each image must be labeled and include a title or description of the work, the medium and the dimensions. If it is three-dimensional state the height, width, depth, and if it is 2 dimensional state the height and width.

**Essay Requirement:** Discuss how art influenced your life, what you feel that you are expressing with your art and why you selected the medium that you use.

**CT – Stanley P. Bitel Memorial Fund****\$5,000**

This scholarship was established in 2015 through gifts from family and friends to honor the life of Stanley P. Bitel, the founder of Rowley Spring and Stamping Corporation in Bristol which was founded in 1954. He personified entrepreneurial spirit, continual learning and self achievement all characteristics that should be displayed by the recipient.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Open to residents of the state of Connecticut who are a graduating high school senior, currently enrolled post secondary student or an adult learner seeking qualifying skilled training in the manufacturing trade*
- *Qualifying training includes apprenticeship programs, technical education/trade schools, workforce development programs or pursuit of a four year degree in business or engineering as it relates to a career in manufacturing*
- *School, community and work history*
- *Academic achievement, with a minimum of a B average (3.0 on a 4.0 scale)*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** One letter of recommendation either from a teacher or an employer that demonstrates that the applicant is a “go-getter”.

***Essay Requirement:*** The manufacturing industry has an abundance of career opportunities including engineering, sales, finance, management, precision machinist, distribution, quality control inspectors, tool & die maker, lean manufacturing, supply chain management, just to name a few.

Write a one page essay introducing yourself and describing why you wish to pursue a career in the manufacturing field.

**Br – Peter and Marjorie Bossi Educational Fund****\$600**

This scholarship was established in 2003 by Marjorie Bossi.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior or graduate of Bristol Central High School*
- *Interest in music*
- *Financial Need*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation with at least one from a teacher.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief essay explaining your goals and any special circumstances that you feel would demonstrate your need for this scholarship.

**Br – Bowerman Scholarship Fund****\$1,500**

This scholarship was established in 2008 by Bryan Bowerman, retired President of Farmington Savings Bank, to give back to his high school and encourage a student in the field of business.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior from Bristol Eastern High School*
- *Student must be accepted and planning to attend the University of Connecticut with preference given to a student attending the School of Business*
- *Academic Achievement*
- *Potential for success in the chosen field*
- *Outstanding character and citizenship*
- *Commitment of service to school and community*
- *Financial Need*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Please submit a copy of your college application essay.

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo, O - Bristol Boys & Girls Club Schulman Fund up to \$5,410**

Established at the Bristol Boys & Girls Club and transferred to Main Street Community Foundation in 2000, this fund provides post-secondary scholarship assistance to current and former members in good standing of the Bristol Boys & Girls Club.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Current or former member in good standing of the Bristol Boys & Girls Club*
- *Student must be accepted at or enrolled in an institution of higher education*
- *Academic Achievement*
- *Financial Need*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief essay about a staff member of the Bristol Boys & Girls Club that has influenced you.

**Br – Bristol Lions Club F. Fred Soliani Memorial Scholarship Fund \$1,000**

This fund was transferred to the Main Street Community Foundation in 2008 and was established by the Bristol Lions Club to honor the memory of F. Fred Soliani, a dedicated and honored member of the Lions Club, a noted Bristol educator and civic activist.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior from Bristol Central or Bristol Eastern High School*
- *Academic achievement*
- *Potential for success in a chosen field*
- *Outstanding character and citizenship*
- *Proof of commitment of service to school and community*
- *Financial need*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Compose a couple paragraphs about yourself focusing on information such as: (1) How community service has impacted your life; and (2) The community service activity that has given you the greatest satisfaction.

**Br – Bristol Police Scholarship Fund \$1,220**

This scholarship was established in 1999 by the Bristol Police Union Local 754 to assist students who wish to pursue a career in law enforcement.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Resident of Bristol and/or graduating senior or graduate of Bristol Central, Bristol Eastern or St. Paul Catholic High School*
- *Pursuing a career in federal, state or local law enforcement or related field*
- *Academic or technical ability*
- *Evidence of good moral character*
- *Financial need*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief essay which includes your high school and community activities, as well as your future plans and goals in law enforcement.

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo – Bristol Yale Club Scholarship Fund****up to \$3,060**

The Bristol Yale Club was established in 1905 as a social and networking group for graduates of Yale University. Over the years its members have assisted many students wishing to attend Yale University. In 1999, club members decided to take a portion of the existing scholarship fund and establish the Bristol Yale Scholarship Fund, which would assist students pursuing a variety of post secondary opportunities and wishing to secure their education at other institutions as well.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Resident of Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington and Wolcott*
- *Academic achievement*
- *Preference to students who have a high degree of financial need*
- *Community involvement*
- *Good moral character*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief statement explaining any special or extenuating circumstances that demonstrate your financial need for this scholarship.

**Bu – Burlington Lions Charities Scholarship Fund****3 @ \$1,000**

This fund was established by this volunteer service organization to support further education opportunities for Burlington residents.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior who are residents of Burlington, even if they attend school outside of town*
- *Will support all forms of higher education i.e. two-year, four-year, technical, etc.*
- *Proof of community service*
- *Have reasonable grades, not necessarily the top of the class*
- *May have some special circumstances which contributes to financial need (answer question in Section V of application)*
- *Students with potential who may not receive assistance from other services*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Detail your involvement with Burlington Lions Club activities over the past four years.

**O – Conn Acoustics Scholarship Fund****up to \$10,000**

This scholarship was established in 2006 by company President Peter LeBlanc to assist employees with post secondary education costs for their children. For purposes of this scholarship, company employment will be defined as anyone employed by Conn Acoustics for at least one year and is employed by them at the time of the application deadline.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Must be a child or grandchild of a Conn Acoustics employee*
- *Be enrolled or about to enroll in some form of post-secondary education including technical education*
- *Must be hardworking and can demonstrate their drive and motivation to succeed*
- *Not automatically renewable but recipients may reapply each year if they continue to meet the criteria*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief statement to tell us about yourself, the personal qualities you value, your future goals in life and how you would use this scholarship.

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo – Peg Coughlin Nursing Scholarship Fund**

**\$1,010**

This scholarship was established in 2000 by the family of Peg Coughlin to honor her lifelong commitment to nursing.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Must live and/or work in Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington or Wolcott*
- *For individuals who are returning to school to complete their nursing studies with preference to individuals with an interest in emergency room or hospice care*
- *Not automatically renewable but recipients may reapply if they continue to meet the criteria*
- *Financial need*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation.

**Essay Requirement:** Write a brief essay explaining where you are in your nursing career, what your future educational goals are and how you plan to use this education in the care of patients.

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo – Rit Croce Academic and Vocational Scholarship**

**\$1,000**

This scholarship was established in 2014 by the family and friends of Rit Croce to honor his life and his commitment to local students.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Resident of Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington or Wolcott*
- *Either an adult returning to school or a graduating senior pursuing post secondary education at a vocational school or a two-year or four-year college or university*
- *Preference will be given primarily to adult learners pursuing a trade or major in education*
- *Financial need*
- *Evidence of good moral character and the ability to deal with challenges/obstacles in life*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation, which must be from a coach, teacher, employer, etc. who knows you well.

**Essay Requirement:** Write a brief essay explaining your goals and any special circumstances that you feel demonstrate your need for this scholarship.

**So - Richard A. DellaVecchia Scholarship Fund**

**up to \$2,290**

This scholarship was first established by the parents of Southington resident Richard Anthony DellaVecchia after his untimely death in a 1989 traffic accident. It was transferred to the Main Street Community Foundation in 2002.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Graduating senior from Southington High School*
- *For individuals continuing their education in the vocational/technical field*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation.

**Essay Requirement:** No essay required.

**Note the deadline for this application is March 13, 2017.**

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo, O – Jeffrey Downes Memorial Truck Driving Scholarship Fund \$500**

Established in 2015, this scholarship fund honors the memory of Jeffrey Downes who passed away in 2015 after a hard fought battle with cancer.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Resident of Bristol, Burlington, Harwinton, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington or Wolcott
- Applicants must be pursuing a commercial driver license at an accredited training school
- May not be at the top of the class academically but maintain a minimum of a C average
- Preference for applicants that do not qualify for financial assistance from other sources
- Must demonstrate a passion for driving

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** No letters of recommendation required.

**Essay Requirements (no more than a paragraph each):**

- Describe your passion for driving and how you plan to use your CDL to accomplish your career goals.
- What is philanthropy and how do you plan to “pay it forward” in the future?

**Ply – Carolyn Fisher Scholarship Fund**

**\$410**

This scholarship was transferred to Main Street Community Foundation from Terryville High School in 2003.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Graduating senior from Terryville High School
- Pursuing a career in education

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation.

**Essay Requirement:** What one improvement would you propose for the education system specifically or overall?

**So – Olivia Fusco Memorial Art Scholarship Fund**

**\$500**

This fund was established in 2016 by the family and friends of Lucinda Fusco to honor the memory of her daughter, Olivia Helene Fusco, a Southington resident, who sadly passed away in 2015 at the young age of 14.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Graduating senior of Southington High School
- Must show proof of a GPA of at least 80
- Pursuing a 2 or 4 year program with a major in visual or performing arts or art education
- Applicant must exhibit leadership qualities
- Involvement in community service
- Must have overcome challenges/obstacles

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** One letter of recommendation from a teacher.

**Essay Requirement:** Write a brief essay explaining how art has influenced your life and how this scholarship will assist you in achieving your career goals.

**Note the deadline for this application is March 13, 2017.**

**O – GE's Industrial Solutions Scholarship Fund up to \$3,000 per award recipient**

This scholarship was transferred to the Main Street Community Foundation in 2015 and was established to provide scholarships to eligible dependents of GE Plainville employees.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Graduating high school seniors or students currently enrolled in a two-year or four-year college*
- *Financial need*
- *Leadership qualities*
- *Community service*
- *Must have a least a 2.75 GPA*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** One letter that addresses the applicant's character, potential for success and leadership qualities.

**Essay Requirement:** Write a 500 word essay that discusses your goals for the future.

**Br – Andrew and Murielle Giacomini Scholarship Fund \$770**

This scholarship was established by the family and friends of Murielle Giacomini after her untimely death in 2003. Murielle was a lifelong Bristol resident with a great love for life and strong professional commitment to helping young women in need. In 2009, the name was changed to also honor the memory of Murielle's husband, Andrew Giacomini.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Female Graduating senior or graduates of Bristol Central High School*
- *Preference to those who played softball in high school*
- *Financial need*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation, with at least one being from a teacher.

**Essay Requirement:** No essay required.

**Br - Azilda Hebert Music Scholarship Fund \$660**

This scholarship was first established by bequest from retired Bristol music teacher Azilda Hebert. It was transferred to the Main Street Community Foundation in 2001.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Graduating senior from Bristol Central or Bristol Eastern High School*
- *Interest in pursuing post-secondary music education*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation, with at least one being from a music teacher.

**Essay Requirement:** How do you plan to use music in your career?

**Br, Ply – Dorothy Micloskey Ives Award \$500**

This scholarship was transferred to the Main Street Community Foundation in 2002 by Dorothy Ives, a former teacher in the Bristol school system.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- *Graduating senior from Terryville High School, Bristol Central High School or Bristol Eastern High School*
- *Interest in pursuing a vocation or apprenticeship in one of the following creative endeavors: dance or gymnastics, drama or stage craft, a music related endeavor or writing, i.e., poetry, fiction or non-fiction.*

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation, one of which must come from a teacher who discusses the applicant's interest in one of the above fields.

**Essay Requirement:** No essay required



**Br – Grace & Norma Joy Scholarship Fund****\$920**

This scholarship was transferred to the Foundation in 2008. It was started by Grace and Norma Joy's nieces, Eileen Moylan, Lorry Belanger and Donna Ricci to honor the memory of these two sisters who would have excelled in college if given the opportunity. Both sisters had a high regard for education and volunteered as mentors in the Bristol school system representing exceptional role models of independence and strength

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior from Bristol Central or Bristol Eastern High School*
- *Financial need*
- *Pursuing post secondary education at either a two or four year college*
- *Potential for success in a chosen field*
- *Outstanding character and citizenship*
- *Commitment of service to school and community*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Submit a copy of your college application essay.

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo – Vincent T. Kozyrski Scholarship Fund****\$400**

This scholarship was established to honor Vincent T. Kozyrski, a long time employee of the Fletcher-Terry Company.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior who resides in or attends high school in Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington or Wolcott*
- *Pursuing post secondary education in the field of engineering at a 4 year college or university*
- *Financial need*
- *Outstanding leadership qualities*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Submit a copy of your college application essay.

**Ply – Sean Landry Memorial Basketball Scholarship Fund****\$640**

This scholarship was established in 2007 in memory of Sean by his family and friends.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior or graduate of Terryville High School*
- *Students must have been a member of the boys or girls basketball team for at least one year during their time in high school; preference will be given to students who have played on the high school basketball team for four years*
- *Must be pursuing post-secondary education at a two-year or four-year college or university or at a technical/vocational school on a full time basis*
- *Must be involved in the community through athletics and/or extracurricular activities*
- *Must have received some type of award for their athletic achievements*
- *Not automatically renewable but students may reapply each year*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from the coach of a team that you have played on and one of which must be from a teacher or employer.

***Essay Requirement:*** On the sports team(s) you are a part of, do you consider yourself a team player and why?

**Br – John J. and Doris Lazorik Memorial Scholarship Fund****up to \$3,240**

This scholarship was established by family and friends to honor Doris Marie (Doucette) Lazorik following her sudden death in 1979

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Graduating senior from Bristol Central High School, Bristol Eastern High School or St. Paul Catholic High School*
- *Attending a 4 year college*
- *Financial need*
- *Academic achievement*
- *Leadership qualities*
- *Job history*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation from someone other than a family member.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief statement to include your school activities and awards, community activities, job history and future plans and goals.

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo - Leger Initiative for Education Fund****\$560**

This scholarship was established in 2005 by the Leger Family to assist women with completing their education. The family recognizes the special challenges faced by women in the work place, and the importance of achieving higher education in order to make a better life for themselves.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Female resident of Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington or Wolcott, with a preference for Bristol residents*
- *Must be a non-traditional student, which can include a student furthering their education at a vocational school or two- or four-year college after taking a period of time off*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a brief essay explaining your goals and any special circumstances that you feel would demonstrate your need for this scholarship.

**Br – Dave Lepore Journalism Scholarship Fund****\$1,070**

This scholarship was established in 2003 to honor the memory of Dave Lepore, who died at age 41. In addition to being a strong supporter of Bristol, Dave was a poet, playwright, novelist, and award-winning journalist. A protégé of Bart Barnes, Dave was a feature writer and columnist for the *Bristol Press*, publisher of the *Lepore Report* and *The Citizen*, and co-publisher and co-editor of the independent weekly newspaper *Bristol Today*. Dave was a graduate of St. Paul Catholic High School and attended Boston University's School of Journalism.

***Eligibility Requirements:***

- *Resident of Bristol*
- *Must be pursuing studies in the field of journalism, which includes broadcast journalism, multimedia journalism, photo journalism and print journalism*
- *Community involvement*

***Letter of Recommendation Requirement:*** Two letters of recommendation, with at least one that addresses the applicant's interest in journalism.

***Essay Requirement:*** Write a 500-word essay that addresses the concept of "hometown".

**So – Thérèse MacCallum “Great Kid” Scholarship Fund****2 @ \$720**

This fund was established in 2005 by the family of Mrs. MacCallum as a testament to her great love of both children and education. The family was honored her wish of starting this scholarship after her death.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Offered to a male and female graduating senior of Southington High School
- Must show proof of a GPA between 77-89 (no higher or lower)
- Community service
- Commitment to a sport and/or music

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** One letter of recommendation. It can be from a parent, relative, teacher or coach explaining why the applicant is just a “great kid” and deserves this scholarship.

**Essay Requirement:** Write a short essay explaining why you are applying for this particular scholarship.

**Note the deadline for this application is March 13, 2017.**

**Br – Nicholas P. Maglio ACE (A Chance for Education) Fund****\$1,000**

This fund was established in 2011 by the family of Nicholas P. Maglio in his memory. Nicholas was a devoted father and Bristol Public School teacher.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Graduating senior of Bristol Eastern High School
- Pursuing post secondary education at a two or four year college or university
- Financial need
- Evidence of good character

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** One letter of recommendation, which must be from a family member or friend describing the student’s character, qualities and the impact the student has had on the recommender’s life.

**Essay Requirement:** Write a brief essay that answers the following questions: Who do you admire? Which of their qualities do you admire most?

**Br, Bu, Pl, Ply, So, Wo-Elizabeth I. and Louis J. Matt Medical Scholarship Fund up to \$4,520**

This fund was established in 2007 by Elizabeth Matt, a retired nurse, for students who wish to pursue some type of education in the medical field.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Graduating senior from high schools in Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth, Southington and Wolcott
- Commitment, interest and passion for some area of the clinical medical profession

**Letter of Recommendation Requirement:** Two letters of recommendation with at least one from a teacher.

**Essay Requirement:** What is it about your chosen medical profession that interests you the most?

**So - Robert E. and Angeline P. McCormack Scholarship Fund**
