

Boys & Girls Club of Bristol has received a combined \$23,652 grant

BRISTOL – The Boys & Girls Club of Bristol has received a combined \$23,652 from the Main Street Community Foundation to support their operating expenses.

The grants include a \$20,201 grant from the Bristol Brass General Fund, \$3,050 from the Clement Family Fund and \$401 from the Hamzy Family Charitable Fund at the Main Street Community Foundation. These funds will be used for unrestricted operating support in response to covid-19.

Heather Grance, director of marketing and development with the Boys & Girls Club of Bristol, said that the funds will go a long way for the club.

“They will help us to maintain the services that we are currently operating, including our distance learning programs,” she said. “They will also help us to return to full capacity once the pandemic subsides.”

Grance said that the Main Street Community Foundation have been “great supporters.”

“They’ve helped us out many times throughout the pandemic,” she said. “We’ve also received operations support from the Men & Boys Fund and the Women & Girls Fund.
