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8 Plainville community projects receive nearly \$16,000 in grants

PLAINVILLE — The Main Street Community Foundation has awarded eight grants totaling \$15,800 through the Plainville Community.

Samantha Rajotte, scholarship and program officer with the Main Street Community Foundation, said the checks were presented this past Sunday to the recipients. Their goal is to “improve the lives of Plainville residents.”

“The grants are for programs such as student enrichment, support services and community programming among other things,” she said. “The Plainville Community Fund was established by Plainville residents to ensure that their neighbors would be taken care of.”

Since the Plainville Community Fund was established as a “permanent resource for charitable programs and projects” in 2006, it has awarded \$160,000 in grants.

The following are this year’s grant recipients:

At Liberty Services - \$1,500 awarded to support the Getting your Documents Ready program, which assists vulnerable individuals and families with personalized case management services to access benefit programs.

Community Solutions, Inc. - \$1,800 for Basic Needs for Teenage Girls at Lisa’s House.

Imagine Nation, A Museum Early Learning Center - \$1,500 awarded for the Imagine Nation Loves Plainville STEAM outreach programs.

PARC, Inc. - \$3,000 awarded to support the Adult Life Skills program for adults with developmental disabilities.

Plainville Board of Education/Plainville Community Schools - \$2,500 for the parent and child nutrition class “Nourish to Flourish.”

Plainville Community Food Pantry - \$2,000 awarded to support the Intervention, Outreach, and Referral Program, which provides food and other basic needs to Plainville residents.

The Congregational Church of Plainville (CCP) - \$1,500 for the “CCP Presents...” concert series which features a variety of music genres and musicians and is open to the public.

Wheeler Regional Family YMCA - \$2,000 awarded to YMCA Day Camp to purchase equipment and supplies to enhance the Camp Wheeler experience.

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
