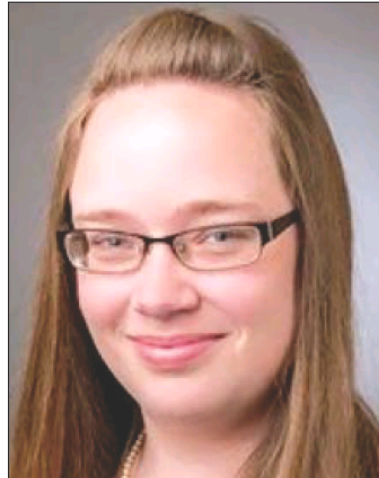

Scholarships available to Plymouth students in health

seniors seeking financial assistance to further post-secondary education or career training in the healthcare field,” Rajotte said. “This can include a healthcare program at a vocational school or community college in an allied health profession, or acceptance at a two-year or four-year college or university pursuing a degree in a healthcare program of study.”
